### What's ASAP?

Our Adaptive Scholastic Athletic Program is a school-based education program that hosts disABILITY awareness assemblies &/or PE Takeovers. We teach students, educators, and administrators by putting them in "a different pair of shoes."



## ASAP Program Overview

ASAP event set-up and tear down typically takes up to 45 minutes each. Plan to have 2-3 volunteers available to assist before and after your planned event.

### ASAP Assembly

An assembly includes a presentation from a wheelchair athlete and time to have select students and staff play wheelchair basketball. The assembly is primarily a visual and auditory learning opportunity. Assemblies typically last up to two hours.

### ASAP PE Takeover

A PE takeover is an immersive and interactive experience for all students involved. TAC will take over your PE classes for the day and teach about various adaptive sports and games in addition to providing some disability awareness training. Each PE class hour can accommodate approximately 20-40 students—depending on age, gym space, and support available. The schedule is customizable, but typically lasts 50-75 minutes each.

**\$2000** – 2 days in a row

### Travel

Events scheduled further than 30 miles of Wauwatosa, Wisconsin will have an additional charge of \$75 and \$0.63/mile. Depending on the length of an event, hotel fees may also be applied.

### Lunch

Plan to provide lunch when programming runs over the noon hour. Typically The Ability Center will have up to four presenters present at an event.
