Adaptive Scholastic Athletic Program

ASAP is a school-based education program that engages students and leads disability awareness training. We teach students, teachers, and administrators by putting them in “a different pair of shoes” and playing wheelchair sports.

Through immersive programming, The Ability Center (TAC) helps educators identify adaptive athletes and teaches regardless of ability, everyBODY is capable!

Interactive Assembly

Our ASAP assemblies include a presentation from a wheelchair athlete and some students and staff will have an opportunity to play wheelchair basketball in this interactive experience. Assemblies typically last 60-90 minutes and can include hundreds of students.
